Who we are

What personal data we collect and why we collect it

This website collects the personal data provided by visitors in forms to subscribe to the newsletter or register for an event – name, surname, e-mail address, phone number, country of residence and the name of any organisation and position the person represents when participating in the event. The purpose of this data collection and processing is to organize and administer events, and to inform the audience about relevant news.

When visitors subscribe to the newsletter or register for events on the site, we collect the data shown in the form, and also the visitor’s IP address and browser user agent string to help spam detection.

Cookies

If you subscribe to the newsletter or register on our site you may opt-in to saving your name, email address and website in cookies. These are for your convenience so that you do not have to fill in your details again when you fill another form on the page. These cookies will last for one year.

Embedded content from other websites

Articles on this site may include embedded content (e.g. videos, images, articles, etc.). Embedded content from other websites behaves in the exact same way as if the visitor has visited the other website.

These websites may collect data about you, use cookies, embed additional third-party tracking, and monitor your interaction with that embedded content, including tracking your interaction with the embedded content if you have an account and are logged in to that website.

How long we retain your data

For visitors who register on our website and/or subscribe to the newsletter, we store the data for two years or as long as it is necessary for the purpose of its collection and legitimate interests, unless legally required otherwise.

What rights you have over your data

All visitors who have used the page, registered for an event or subscribed to the newsletter, can request to see, edit, or delete their personal information at any time, by contacting personasdati@bsf.lv.

Where your data is sent

Data put in the registration form for the newsletter or registration for events will be sent to the Mailchimp data base and Mitto registration platform managed by the Children’s Hospital Foundation with the purpose of managing e-mail communication and newsletters through mailing lists. Children’s Hospital Foundation does not share the data with third persons, unless it is legally required or explicitly requested by the data subject.
